RESOLUTION NO. 88-14

APPROVAL OF THE SUPPLEMENTAL SECTION 106 WATER POLLUTION CONTROL
GRANT AND WORKPLAN FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 1988

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) is applying to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for a Clean Water Act, supplemental Section 106 Grant in the amount of \$547,000 for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1988.
2. The supplemental Section 106 Grant for water pollution control programs assists the State Board in financing the implementation and maintenance of adequate measures for the prevention and abatement of water pollution, water pollution control studies, and compliance and enforcement activities.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Approves the supplemental 106 Workplan.
2. Authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to apply for and accept the FFY 1988 supplemental Section 106 Grant in the amount of \$547,000 to assist in financing the State's water pollution control programs.
