APPROVAL TO AWARD SUPPLEMENTAL STATE GRANT ASSISTANCE
TO THE CITY OF FORTUNA, HOME AVENUE AREA
CLEAN WATER GRANT NO. C-06-2982-110

WHEREAS:


1. The City of Fortuna, Home Avenue Area project is scheduled to receive an EPA/State grant in August 1988 for a total federal eligible cost of \$286,012; and
2. The Home Avenue Area has a population less than 5,000 and the total eligible project costs are estimated to be under \$2.5 million; and
3. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy for the Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 provides that communities may receive a supplemental state assistance grant after receiving approval of final plans and specifications; and
4. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy provides that the amount of the supplemental grant be determined by using the formula contained in that document; and
5. The requested supplemental grant will not result in a combined federal and state assistance of more than 97.5 percent of the state eligible project costs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Has determined that the City of Fortuna is eligible to receive a supplemental state grant under the 1984 Clean Water Bond Law; and
2. Approves the award of state supplemental grant assistance in the estimated amount of \$185,800 to the City of Fortuna.
