STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 88-45

GUIDANCE REGARDING STATE SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT ASSISTANCE FOR A SEGMENT OF A LARGER COMMUNITY

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 provides that a "reasonably isolated and divisible segment" of a larger municipality encompassing 5,000 persons or less may be eligible for supplemental state assistance; and
- There is no guidance for determining what constitutes a "reasonably isolated and divisible segment" of a larger municipality.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board will only consider offering supplemental assistance to a segment of a larger community if such segment is physically isolated and distinct from a larger community, or has traditionally funded or provided its own services separate from the parent community. In addition the following factors must be met:

- A water quality problem exists in the segment that is separate and distinct from the parent community; and
- 2. The segment is essentially separated from the parent community by intervening undeveloped land.
