

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 88- 91

LOAN FUNDING APPROVAL FOR: 1) DBCP REMOVAL PROJECT (CITY OF REDLANDS; 2) DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (RECLAMATION DISTRICT #999); 3) EVAPORATION BASIN PROJECT (TULARE LAKE DRAINAGE DISTRICT); AND 4) DEEP WELL INJECTION PROJECT (WESTLANDS WATER DISTRICT)

WHEREAS:

1. The Water Conservation and Water Quality Bond Law of 1986 established the Agricultural Drainage Water Management Loan Program to provide financial assistance for the design and construction of agricultural drainage water management facilities;
2. The Agricultural Drainage Water Account was established with \$75 million for loans to local agencies for a) design and construction of agricultural drainage water management facilities, and b) feasibility studies of projects potentially eligible for funding;
3. The City of Redlands has applied for a \$2,750,000 loan from the Agricultural Drainage Water Account for a DBCP Removal Project;
4. Reclamation District #999 has applied for a \$500,000 loan from the Agricultural Drainage Water Account for a Drainage Improvement Project;
5. Tulare Lake Drainage District has applied for a \$1,000,000 loan from the Agricultural Drainage Water Account for an Evaporation Basin Project;
6. Westlands Water District has applied for a \$1,498,000 loan from the Agricultural Drainage Water Account for a Deep Well Injection Project; and
7. The Division of Loans and Grants recommends the City of Redland's DBCP Removal Project, Reclamation District #999's Drainage Improvement Project, Tulare Lake Drainage District's Evaporation Basin Project, and Westland Water District's Deep Well Injection Project for loan funding.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Approves the loan funding requests of the City of Redlands, Reclamation District #999, Tulare Lake Drainage District, and Westlands Water District; and
2. Authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to execute after the State Legislative approval, for and on behalf of the State Board, contracts and amendments thereto with the City of Redlands, Reclamation District #999.

Tulare Lake Drainage District, and Westlands Water District for loans under the Water Conservation and Water Quality Bond Law of 1986, and to perform all acts and to do all things necessary to implement such contracts.
