STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 88- 100

APPROVAL OF THE SECTION 106 WATER POLLUTION CONTROL GRANT AND WORKPLAN FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 1989

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) is applying to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 9 (EPA) for a Clean Water Act, Section 106 Grant in the amount of \$3,500,000 for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1989.
- 2. The Section 106 Grant for water pollution control programs assists the State Board in financing the implementation and maintenance of adequate measures for the prevention and abatement of water pollution, pollution control studies, compliance and enforcement activities, and ground water activities.
- 3. In order to receive federal funds, the State Board will enter into a signed State/EPA agreement on the State Water Quality Management Program for FFY 1989.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Approves the FFY 1989 Section 106 Grant and workplan.

2. Authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to accept the FFY 1989 Section 106 Grant in the amount of \$3,500,000 to assist in financing the State's water pollution control programs.
