STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 88-102

AUTHORIZATION TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT AND AMENDMENTS WITH A FINANCIAL CONSULTANT TO CONDUCT AN IN-DEPTH STUDY OF THE FINANCING ALTERNATIVES FOR THE STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Water Quality Act of 1987 (Act) authorized federal monies to create a State Revolving Fund Loan Program which replaces the Federal Clean Water Grant Program.
- 2. The Act provides for other uses of the federal capitalization grant as follows:
 - refinancing existing debt obligations,
 - o guaranteeing or purchasing insurance for local debt obligations,
 - o as a source of revenue or security for the payment of principal and interest on revenue or general obligation bonds, and
 - o providing loan guarantees for similar revolving funds established by municipal or intermunicipal agencies.
- 3. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) in establishing its SRF Program wishes to investigate alternatives or a combination of alternatives that will maximize the water quality benefits which can be obtained using this source of funding.
- 4. The State Board requires the services and expertise of a financial consultant to conduct an in-depth study of the alternatives available.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute a contract and amendments to conduct an investigation of the other uses of the SRF monies funded with \$50,000 in 1984 Bond Fund monies, \$15,000 in FFY 1988 205(g) contract monies and \$135,000 in FFY 1988 205(g) operating expense monies for a total amount not to exceed \$200,000.
