APPROVAL OF A POLLUTION STUDY GRANT FOR THE COMMUNITY OF GUALALA  
NO. C-06-2978-110

WHEREAS:


1. The Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 established the State Supplemental Grant Assistance Program to help small communities with funding for wastewater treatment works;
2. The Supplemental State Grant Assistance Program provides grant assistance in amounts up to 97-1/2 percent to fund pollution studies;
3. The Gualala Community Services District contracted with Oscar Larson and Associates for their services to conduct a pollution study for a price of \$27,000; and
4. Based on the findings of the pollution study, the Gualala Communities Services District project was given an A priority and placed on the 1988 Project Priority List for Clean Water Grant funding.
5. The Gualala Community Services District requests to be reimbursed for 97-1/2 percent of the pollution study cost.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize a Pollution Study Grant to be issued to the Gualala Community Services District in the amount of \$26,325.
