RESOLUTION NO. 88- 105

APPROVAL TO AWARD SUPPLEMENTAL STATE GRANT ASSISTANCE TO
THE COMMUNITY OF PENRYN (PLACER COUNTY)

WHEREAS:


1. The community of Penryn (Placer County) -- C-06-1643-110, a small community, has requested state supplemental grant assistance, under the Clean Water Bond Law of 1984. The estimated supplemental grant amount of \$654,830 has been computed by the Division of Loans and Grants in accordance with the State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy dated May 1, 1985.
2. The Division of Loans and Grants has determined that the proposed project is the most cost-effective solution to the water quality or public health problem;
3. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy, dated May 1985, provides that the amount of the supplemental grant be determined by using the formula contained in that document, provided that the total amount of combined grant assistance shall not exceed 97-1/2 percent of the total project cost; and
4. The State Board may at its option award a supplemental grant less than that amount determined by using the formula referred to in (3) above.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Has determined that the above listed project is eligible for supplemental grants under the 1984 Clean Water Bond law; and
2. Approves the award of supplemental state grant assistance for the above project in the approximate amount indicated.
