## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 88- 115

DIRECTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A GRANT FOR A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) REGION 9 TO ACCELERATE SOURCE INVESTIGATION ACTIVITIES IN THE SAN GABRIEL VALLEY

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The San Gabriel Valley ground water basin provides drinking water for over one million people.
- 2. A portion of the San Gabriel Valley ground water basin is contaminated with volatile organic compounds at levels exceeding state and federal health standards.
- 3. The San Gabriel Valley ground water basin was placed on EPA's National Priorities List (Superfund) in 1984.
- 4. The Los Angeles Regional Board has been investigating sources of ground water contamination in the San Gabriel Valley since October 1985 in an attempt to identify potential responsible parties.
- 5. At its April 1988 meeting, the Los Angeles Regional Board endorsed a program strategy and action plan for accelerating the cleanup of the basin.
- 6. EPA is making available to the State Board a grant which would fund additional staff positions to accelerate source identification activities in the San Gabriel Valley.

## THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Executive Director or his designee is directed to apply for and accept a grant and enter into a cooperative agreement with the EPA to accelerate source investigation activities in the San Gabriel Valley.
