RESOLUTION NO. 88- 132

GRANTING UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK TESTERS ONE YEAR, BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1989, TO ACQUIRE QUALIFYING EXPERIENCE FOR LICENSING; AND DEFINING QUALIFYING EXPERIENCE

WHEREAS:

- Section 25284.4 of the Health and Safety Code requires the State Board to license underground storage tank testers by January 1, 1989.
- 2. Section 25284.4(c) of the Health and Safety Code requires that each applicant for licensure as a tank tester: 1) demonstrate a minimum of either one year of qualifying experience in testing underground storage tanks or have successfully completed a course of study applicable to tank testing which is satisfactory to the State Board; and, 2) pass an examination specified by the State Board.
- 3. Section 25284.4(a) of the Health and Safety Code allows the State Board to extend the January 1, 1989 deadline for a period of not more than one year to give tank testers a reasonable opportunity to qualify for licensing.
- 4. The State Board desires to allow tank testers the maximum time allowed under the statute to qualify for licensing.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The State Board extends the January 1, 1989 deadline for licensing tank testers to January 1, 1990.
- 2. "Qualifying Experience" means, prior to January 1, 1990, experience in all aspects of tank testing including setting up and operating equipment, collecting data and producing reports, after successfully completing training and receiving a certificate of completion of training from a manufacturer in the appropriate test procedures. On and after January 1, 1990, "qualifying experience" means experience in all aspects of tank including setting up and operating equipment, collecting data and producing reports under the direct and personal supervision of a licensed tank tester, during which time training is successfully completed and a certificate of completion of training is received from a manufacturer in the appropriate test procedures.
