STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 89-18

ACCEPTANCE OF THE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK (UST) PETROLEUM TRUST FUND GRANT FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR (FFY) 1989 FROM THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA)

WHEREAS:

- 1. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 9, is offering a \$3.9 million UST Trust Fund grant to the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) for FFY 1989.
- 2. To date over 9,300 leaking USTs have been identified in California.
- The Trust Fund allotment will augment the state leaking UST cleanup program.
- 4. The State Board will enter into a signed State/EPA agreement on the UST program for FFY 1989 in order to receive federal funds.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board hereby:

- 1. Authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to accept the UST Trust Fund grant in the amount of up to \$3.9 million after obtaining the necessary administrative approvals.
- 2. That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to execute a revised UST Trust Fund cooperative agreement with EPA, Region 9.
