## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 89-27

AUTHORIZATION TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT AND AMENDMENTS THERETO WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, BERKELEY (UCB) TO DEVELOP A GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM FOR TOXIC CLEANUP SITES IN SANTA CLARA COUNTY

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) has oversight responsibility for toxic cleanup sites at Stanford Park and at other sites in Santa Clara County.
- 2. The Regional Board will need a geographic information system to carry out this cleanup activity.
- 3. Development and implementation of the geographic information system will require the services and expertise of the UCB staff.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Resources Control Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute an interagency agreement and amendments thereto with the UCB to develop and implement a geographic information system for the toxic cleanup sites in Santa Clara County, in an amount not to exceed \$162,000.
