STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 89-42

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME FOR CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE TOXIC SUBSTANCES MONITORING PROGRAM IN FY 1989-90

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) has the responsibility to monitor the occurrence of toxic substances in the waters of the State.
- 2. The State Board's Toxic Substances Monitoring Program (TSMP) is providing valuable information on the occurrence of toxic substances in the State's fresh surface waters.
- 3. It is desirable that this program be continued, consistent with the State Board's emphasis on the control of toxic substances.
- 4. The Department of Fish and Game has qualified personnel, facilities, and experience to continue operation of this program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute an interagency agreement with the Department of Fish and Game for continued operation of the TSMP through June 30, 1990, for a total amount not to exceed \$380,000; which includes \$230,000 in FY 1988-89 bond fund monies, \$100,000 in federal Section 314 LWQA fund monies, and \$50,000 in federal supplemental grant monies, subject to the availability of funds.
