# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD

## RESOLUTION NO. 89-45

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, OR
HIS DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT
A CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 205(j)(5) GRANT
FOR NONPOINT SOURCE IMPLEMENTATION AND DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

#### WHEREAS:

- Section 205(j)(5) of the Federal Clean Water Act reserves grant funds for states to carry out Section 319 "Nonpoint Source Management Programs".
- A Section 205(j)(5) appropriation of \$1.6 million was reserved for California from Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1988 monies.
- 3. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) approved a <u>Nonpoint Source Management Plan</u> on November 15, 1988 which includes activities which the State Board and Regional Water Quality Conbtrol Boards (Regional Boards) will undertake to manage nonpoint sources.
- 4. Workplans have been developed identifying implementation and development activities consistent with the Nonpoint Source Management Plan which will be supported by Section 205(j)(5) FFY 1988 grant funds.
- 5. A notice of intent has been submitted to the State Clearinghouse advising of the State Board's plans to apply for the Section 205(j)(5) funds.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director, or his designee, to:

- Apply for and accept a Section 205(j)(5) grant for an amount up to \$1.6 million to support the Nonpoint Source Program.
- 2. Negotiate, execute, and/or amend contracts and agreements in accordance with the program workplans.
- Negotiate and execute modifications to the program workplans not affecting the total grant amount.
