RESOLUTION NO. 89-46

ACCEPTANCE OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY  
CONTROL BOARD, NORTH COAST REGION'S 205(j)(2) PHASE II  
FINAL REPORT AND THREE INTERIM REPORTS AS COMPLETION  
OF THE "TOXIC SUBSTANCES DETECTION AND EARLY WARNING  
FOR THE RUSSIAN RIVER PROJECT"

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to the terms of the 205(j)(2) Phase II grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided funds to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (North Coast Regional Board) to conduct a project entitled "Toxic Substances Detection and Early Warning for the Russian River Project" (Project).
2. The North Coast Regional Board, in cooperation with the Sonoma County Water Agency and N.E.T. Pacific, Inc. (formerly Anatec Laboratories), contracted with Sonoma State University and Anatec Laboratories to conduct the study.
3. The North Coast Regional Board has accepted and submitted to the State Board the Final Report and three interim reports entitled Final Report on Toxic Substances Detection and Early Warning for the Russian River, Estimation of Russian River Travel Times with Proposed Siting for Toxic Substances Early Warning in the Russian River Basin, Implementation of Special Monitoring with Macro-Reticular Resins in the Russian River Basin, Sonoma County, California, and Investigation of a Video-Based Motion Analysis System for Early Warning of Toxic Substances in Drinking Water Supplies.
4. The State Board finds that the Project reports conform to the requirements of the EPA 205(j)(2) Phase II grant and workplan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Accepts the Project reports as completion of the North Coast Regional Board's 205(j)(2) Phase II Project.

2. Directs staff to transmit the Project reports to EPA as completion of the North Coast Regional Board's 205(j)(2) Phase II Project.
