ACCEPTANCE OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, NORTH COAST REGION'S PHASE II 205(j)(2) FINAL REPORT AS COMPLETION OF THE "GROUNDWATER POLLUTION BY PESTICIDES ON THE SMITH RIVER PLAINS, DEL NORTE COUNTY" PROJECT

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase II 205(j)(2) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided \$97,500 to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (North Coast Regional Board) to conduct a study to investigate ground water pollution by pesticides in the Smith River Plains in Del Norte County.
- The North Coast Regional Board has completed and submitted the final report to the State Board entitled <u>Groundwater</u>

 <u>Pollution by Pesticides on the Smith River Plains, Del Norte County</u> (Final Report).
- 3. The State Board has found that the Final Report conforms to the requirements of the Phase II grant and project workplan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- Accepts the Final Report as completion of the North Coast Regional Board's Phase II 205(j)(2) project.
- 2. Directs State Board staff to transmit the Final Report to EPA as completion of the North Coast Regional Board's Phase II 205(j)(2) "Groundwater Pollution by Pesticides on the Smith River Plains, Del Norte County" Project.
