# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 89-71

ACCEPTANCE OF THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD, DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY'S PLANNING AND STANDARDS DEVELOPMENT BRANCH'S 205(j)(2) PHASE III FINAL REPORT AS COMPLETION OF THE "MARINE BIOASSAY AND TOXIC SUBSTANCES CRITERIA DEVELOPMENT PROJECT"

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to the terms of the Phase III 205(j)(2) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided \$140,000 to the Division of Water Quality's Planning and Standards Development Branch to conduct the third part of a study to develop protocols for a sublethal aquatic toxicity test using native marine species.
- 2. The Division of Water Quality's Planning and Standards Development Branch has completed and submitted to the State Board a final report for the third part of the study, entitled <u>Experimental Evaluation of Effluent Toxicity Testing</u> <u>Protocols with Giant Kelp, Mysids, Abalone, and Topsmelt,</u> (Final Report).
- The State Board finds that the Final Report conforms to the requirements of the Phase III grant and the project workplan.

#### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

### That the State Board:

- 1. Accepts the aforementioned Final Report as completion of the Division of Water Quality's Planning and Standards Development Branch's Phase III 205(j)(2) Project.
- 2. Directs staff to transmit the Final Report to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) as completion of the Division of Water Quality's Planning and Standards Development Branch's Phase III 205(j)(2) "Marine Bioassay and Toxic Substances Criteria Development Project".

 Directs staff to have the Final Report for the third phase published as the fourth report in the Marine Bioassay Project series.
