APPROVAL TO AWARD SUPPLEMENTAL STATE GRANT ASSISTANCE
TO THE CITY OF GRASS VALLEY FOR THE NEVADA UNION HIGH
SCHOOL (NUHS) PROJECT - CLEAN WATER GRANT NO. C-06-2820-130

WHEREAS:


1. The City of Grass Valley has requested Supplemental State Grant Assistance for the NUHS project, under the Clean Water Bond Law of 1984, in the estimated amount of \$90,000;
2. The Nevada Union High School and surrounding community have a population of less than 5,000 and total eligible project costs are estimated to be under \$2.5 million;
3. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy for the Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 provides that the amount of the supplemental grant be determined by using the formula contained in that document; and
4. The requested supplemental grant will not result in a combined federal and state assistance of more than 97.5 percent of the state eligible project cost.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Has determined that the City of Grass Valley (Nevada Union High School) project is eligible to receive a supplemental state grant under the 1984 Clean Water Bond Law.
2. Approves the award of supplemental state grant assistance in the estimated amount of \$90,000 to the City of Grass Valley.
