RESOLUTION NO. 89-86

ACCEPTANCE OF THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY,
PLANNING AND STANDARD DEVELOPMENT BRANCH'S
PHASE II 205(j)(2) FINAL REPORT FROM THE "208 WATER
QUALITY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FOR FOREST ACTIVITIES PROJECT"

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided \$77,300 of redirected Federal Phase II 205(j)(2) funds to the Division of Water Quality for the "208 Water Quality Management Program for Forest Activities Project" (Project) to provide a continuation of the Forest Practice Rules Assessment Project.
2. The continuation project has allowed the State Board to complete and execute a Management Agency Agreement with the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CDF) and the State Board of Forestry (BOF) to certify the "Water Quality Management Plan for Timber Operation of Nonfederal Lands" and to designate CDF and BOF as joint management agencies for plan implementation.
3. The Division of Water Quality, Planning and Standards Branch's staff completed and submitted to the State Board the Final Report for the Project (Final Report), which addresses the activities conducted during the Project (December 1987 through June 1988) and during the subsequent period (July 1988 through September 1988) when the program was funded with State General Fund monies.
4. The State Board finds that the Final Report conforms to the requirements of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Phase II 205(j)(2) grant and workplan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Accepts the aforementioned Final Report as completion of the Division of Water Quality, Planning and Standards Development Branch's Phase II 205(j)(2) Project.

2. Directs State Board staff to transmit the Final Report to EPA as completion of the Division of Water Quality, Planning and Standards Development Branch's Phase II 205(j)(2) "208 Water Quality Management Program for Forest Activities Project".
