STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 89-87

CONTRACT TO CONTINUE THE SELENIUM VERIFICATION STUDY FOR FY 1989-90 RELATIVE TO THE REGULATION OF SUBSURFACE AGRICULTURAL DRAINAGE

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board has a need to continue the Selenium Verification Study to assess the impact of selenium in biota of the Bay-Delta Estuary and Sacramento-San Joaquin River Basin.
- The State Water Resources Control Board has a need to continue the Selenium Verification Study to generate information needed for its regulatory program on the agricultural and other discharges of selenium.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Resources Control Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute a one-year contract with the California Department of Fish and Game to continue the Selenium Verification Study during FY 1989-90 for an amount not to exceed \$167,000.
