## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 88-89

APPROVAL OF THE REQUEST
FOR \$65,000 FROM THE
WATER POLLUTION CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT
FOR NUISANCE ABATEMENT IN THE TIJUANA RIVER VALLEY

## WHEREAS:

- The County of San Diego has requested \$65,000 from the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account to pay the cost of a study evaluating environmental impacts of alternatives for nuisance abatement in the Tijuana River Valley; and
- 2. Large mosquito populations have been caused by the severe pollution of the Tijuana River by sewage.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

- 1. Orders that the amount of \$65,000 from the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account be paid to San Diego County to be used for the purposes specified in the recitals of this resolution.
- 2. All unexpended funds shall automatically revert to the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account twelve months from the date of encumbrance, unless a time extension is granted by the Executive Director or designee.
- 3. Upon completion of the work funded under this resolution, San Diego County shall submit a report to the Office of the Chief Counsel describing the work accomplished and discussing any possible recoupment of funds.
- 4. Any funds which are recouped shall be returned to the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account.
