## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 90-11

AUTHORIZATION TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS AND AMENDMENTS TO INVESTIGATE AND REMEDIATE LEAKING ORPHAN UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK (UST) SITES

## WHEREAS:

- 1. Approximately 12,000 leaking UST sites have been reported to the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) of which it is estimated that five percent may be considered orphan sites which either have no identifiable responsible owners or are owned by insolvent parties.
- 2. The State Board approved \$2.0 million to initiate cleanup of orphan UST sites which will be funded from the federal Trust Fund.
- 3. The State Board requires the services of firms with the technical expertise needed to perform a variety of cleanup activities.
- 4. It is necessary for the State Board to augment up to three Pilot Program LIA contracts for overseeing the orphan site cleanup activities.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute contracts and amendments to clean up leaking orphan UST sites funded from the federal Trust Fund in an amount not to exceed \$1.6 million; and amendments to LIA contracts for additional oversight responsibility in an amount not to exceed \$0.3 million.
