STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 90-12

POLICY FOR USE OF CARRYOVER GRANT FUNDS AND DEOBLIGATIONS

WHEREAS:

- 1. On June 30, 1989 the last grant for construction of new wastewater treatment facilities was issued per SWRCB Resolution No. 88-128;
- 2. The Board approved, per SWRCB Resolution No. 89-69, a priority system for grant increases;
- 3. Remaining at this time are \$29.4 million in the Environmental Protection Agency funds; and
- 4. The Board desires to use the remaining funds for grant increases. There may be additional funds available from future grant decreases and/or reallocation of Environmental Protection Agency funds.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- A. That eight million Environmental Protection Agency dollars are reserved until January 1, 1991 to fund all of the known projects in Categories 1 and 2 and that they be funded as they are ready;
- B. The remaining funds be used for projects in Categories 3 and 4 and that they also be funded as they are ready;
- C. If insufficient funds remain to fund all of the projects that are ready to be funded in a category, grants in that category will be increased in the order of the last date that costs in question were finally determined to be eligible by the Division of Loans, Tanks, and Land Disposal or the Corps of Engineers or the Environmental Protection Agency; and
- D. That only Categories 1, 2, 3, and 4 continue to be funded at this time.
