RESOLUTION NO. 90-29

UPDATE TO THE SMALL COMMUNITY
GRANT PROGRAM PROJECT PRIORITY LIST

WHEREAS:

1. The voters approved the Clean Water and Water Reclamation Bond Law of 1988 which authorizes \$25 million in funds to construct wastewater treatment facilities for small communities;
2. At the September 6, 1989 Workshop, over half the respondents asked for a delay in the adoption of the Priority List in order to add additional projects;
3. The Division received packages from the San Francisco Bay, the North Coast, the Central Valley, the Lahontan and the San Diego Regional Boards requesting the placement of additional projects to the Small Community Priority List;
4. The Division has reviewed the requests received and finds that 16 requests, totaling \$12,843,000, meet the requirements for placement on the Priority List;
5. Other projects may be brought to the State Board for addition to the List if they meet the requirements; and
6. At its March 7, 1990 Workshop and March 22, 1990 regular meeting, the State Board expressed concern about certain parts of the Implementation Policy.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Approves the attached, updated Small Community Grant Priority List;
2. Directs that placement of a project on the statewide list shall not constitute a commitment to fund the project;
3. Directs that projects for Eagle Lake and Mustang Mesa be brought back to the State Board for consideration for addition to the Priority List after completion of the public health studies currently underway; and

4. Directs staff to prepare an analysis of the issues and provide recommendations regarding needed changes to the adopted Implementation Policy.
