RESOLUTION NO. 90-47

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO NEGOTIATE, EXECUTE, AND AMEND, AS NECESSARY, AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME TO CONTINUE OPERATION OF THE TOXIC SUBSTANCES MONITORING PROGRAM IN FISCAL YEARS 1990-91, 1991-92, AND 1992-93

WHEREAS:


1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) has the responsibility to monitor the occurrence of toxic substances in the waters of the State.
2. The State Board's Toxic Substances Monitoring Program provides valuable information on the occurrence of toxic substances in the State's fresh surface waters.
3. It is desirable that this program be continued, consistent with the State Board's emphasis on the control of toxic substances.
4. The Department of Fish and Game has qualified personnel, facilities, and experience to continue operation of this program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate, execute, and amend, as necessary, an interagency agreement with the Department of Fish and Game to continue operation of the Toxic Substances Monitoring Program in Fiscal Years 1990-91, 1991-92, and 1992-93 for an amount not to exceed \$400,000 per year (total over three years of \$1,200,000).
