

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 90-50

APPROVAL OF THE REQUEST
FOR \$300,000 FROM THE
WATER POLLUTION CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT
FOR POLLUTION CLEANUP AT PENN MINE

WHEREAS:

1. The Central Valley Regional Board has requested \$300,000 from the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account to pay for design of pollution abatement measures at the Penn Mine site, as follows:
 - a. Engineering survey and topographic map preparation;
 - b. Geologic and soils field investigation and mapping;
 - c. Characterization and mapping of surface hydrology;
 - d. Characterization and volume determinations of solid waste materials, liquids, solutions, and waters;
 - e. Identification of attainable treatment goals and methodologies;
 - f. Design of a monitoring program to assess project's success in achieving identified goals;
 - g. Pilot study of feasible remedial measures;
 - h. Selection and design of cleanup alternative;
 - i. Presentation of data in a report.
2. The Central Valley Regional Board plans to use these funds over a two-year period.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Authorizes the amount of up to \$300,000 from the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account be allocated to the Central Valley Regional Board, to be used for the purposes specified in the recitals of this resolution.
2. All unexpended funds shall automatically revert to the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account two years from the date of encumbrance, unless a time extension is granted by the Executive Director or his designee.

3. Upon completion of the work funded under this resolution, the Central Valley Regional Board shall submit a report to the Office of Chief Counsel describing the work accomplished and discussing any possible recoupment of funds.
4. Any funds which are recouped shall be returned to the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account.
