ADOPTING THE PROPOSED 1990 PRIORITY LIST FOR THE AGRICULTURAL DRAINAGE WATER MANAGEMENT LOAN PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- 1. California's abundant streams, rivers, bays, estuaries, and ground water are threatened with pollution from agricultural drainage water.
- 2. The Water Conservation and Water Quality Bond Law of 1986 provides funds for the construction of cost-effective containment structures and treatment facilities for agricultural drainage water.
- 3. Loan applications are presently on file for sixteen agricultural drainage water management projects.
- 4. A priority list of projects eligible for funding under the Agricultural Drainage Water Management Loan Program is necessary for the effective implementation of the loan program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

Adopts the 1990 Agricultural Drainage Water Management Loan Program Priority List.
