

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 90-92

PARTIAL APPROVAL OF THE REQUEST
FOR SET ASIDE OF UP TO \$4,600,000 FROM THE
WATER POLLUTION CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT
FOR GROUND WATER TREATMENT PROJECTS
IN THE AZUSA/BALDWIN PARK AREA

WHEREAS:


1. The Main San Gabriel Basin Water Quality Authority (Authority) has requested that up to \$4,600,000 from the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account be set aside for a ground water treatment project in the Azusa/Baldwin Park area of the San Gabriel Ground Water Basin. Of that amount, \$2,600,000 is for operation and maintenance costs for the first five years of the project.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Orders that the amount of \$2,920,000 from the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account be designated to pay for a ground water treatment project to be undertaken by the Authority. Disbursements are limited or as follows: Up to \$1,215,000 for capital costs; up to \$80,000 for planning and technical review costs; and up to \$1,625,000 to pay a portion of the operation and maintenance costs for the first five years. These funds shall not be disbursed until the Authority submits specific requests for approval by the Executive Director.
2. All unexpended funds shall automatically revert to the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account twelve months from the date of disbursement approval, unless a time extension is granted by the Executive Director or his designee.
3. Upon completion of the work funded under this resolution, the Authority shall submit a report to the Office of Chief Counsel describing the work accomplished and discussing any possible recoupment of funds.
4. The Executive Director shall apply to the Bank of America to reimburse the Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account from the Azusa Escrow for a portion of the funds disbursed for the project approved pursuant to this resolution.
