STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 90-94

WAIVER OF \$40 MILLION CAP ON FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR (FFY) 1990 FUNDS AND APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO, OCEANSIDE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL PLANT PROJECT NO. C-06-4000-160

WHEREAS:

- The federal government has revised the federal Clean Water Act to implement a SRF Loan Program;
- The State Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Facilities";
- 3. The State Board, on September 6, 1989, adopted the FFY 1990 SRF Priority List and Intended Use Plan:
- 4. The Division has reviewed the subject project and found it in compliance with applicable rules and has approved the project report, the environmental document, and the revenue program;
- 5. As of August 9, 1990, there is a total of \$77.2 million in FFY 1989 and 1990 funds available for loan approval;
- The City and County of San Francisco, by letter dated July 12, 1990, requested that the State Board waive the \$40 million cap on FFY 1990 funds;
- 7. The Division has analyzed the availability of funds and finds that there is one other applicant ready to use FFY 1990 funds; and
- 8. The City of San Francisco has agreed to repay the loan in 15 years, in return for waiving the \$40 million cap, which is a benefit to the growth of the SRF program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board waives the \$40 million cap on FFY 1990 funds and approves the issuance of a \$42.2 million loan to the City and County of San Francisco for the Oceanside Water Pollution Control Plant (Project No. C-06-4000-160) with a repayment period of 15 years and with the first repayment due one (1) year after the first loan repayment, and

2. That the funding will be made up of \$15.1 million from FFY 1989 funds and \$27.1 million from FFY 1990 funds, leaving a total of \$35 million in FFY 1990 funds for assistance to other agencies.
