## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 90-113

# APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN TO THE FRESNO METROPOLITAN FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT

#### WHEREAS:

- The Fresno Metropolitan Flood Control District (District) has requested a \$20,136,450 loan from the State Revolving Fund (SRF) to implement the Stormwater Quality Management Project and Stormwater Quality Program of the District's Storm Drainage and Flood Control Master Plan (Plan);
- The Plan incorporates elements and objectives consistent with the recommendations of the Nationwide Urban Runoff Program for the Fresno area for reducing pollutant loading from urban runoff; and
- The District's Plan, when implemented, will result in improved water supply through utilization of stormwater for groundwater recharge.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- That the Intended Use Plan is amended to include the District's Stormwater Quality Management Project and Stormwater Quality Management Program.
- 2. That the Nonpoint Source Management Plan is amended to include the District's Stormwater Management Project and Stormwater Management Program.
- 3. That the SRF Priority List is amended to include the District's project and program as a fundable project.
- 4. That a SRF loan of \$20,136,450 is approved for the Fresno Metropolitan Flood Control District of which \$15,000,000 will be allocated from the 1990 SRF funds and \$5,136,450 from the 1991 SRF funds.
- 5. That the repayment period shall be 20 years with the first payment due one (1) year after purchase of the first infiltration basin site.
