# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 91-6

# APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO (CITY) LAKE MERCED TRANSPORT FACILITIES

## WHEREAS:

- The State Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities" and amended it on September 20, 1990;
- The State Board, on September 20, 1990, adopted the FFY 1991 SRF Loan Program Priority List and approved the FFY 1991 SRF Intended Use Plan;
- 3. The State Board, on September 20, 1990, approved a twenty percent (20%) setaside of the FFY 1991 Capitalization Grant for construction of new collection systems and combined sewer overflow correction projects;
- 4. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and the revenue program for the City and County of San Francisco Lake Merced Transport project; and
- 5. The information contained in the Negative Declaration and Initial Study prepared for the project (State Clearinghouse No. 88072603) has been reviewed and considered, and:
  - A. Changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into, the project which avoid or substantially lessen the potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the Negative Declaration and Initial Study with respect to the following aspects of the project: (i) biological impacts will be mitigated by replanting with native vegetation and avoiding construction during bird breeding season; and (ii) water quality will be mitigated by preparing a dewatering and ground water management plan, providing alternative water supplies for affected wells, keeping construction away from Lake Merced, and using erosion control measures.
  - B. With respect to the other potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the Negative Declaration and Initial Study, appropriate changes or alterations are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of other public agencies and such other changes or alterations have been adopted or can and should be adopted by such other agencies.

#### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That a SRF loan of \$30.0 million is approved for the San Francisco Lake Merced Transport Facilities, Project No. C-06-4023-310, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first repayment to be due one (1) year after the first loan disbursement.
