RESOLUTION NO. 91-7

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR THE
CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO--MARIPOSA PROJECT

WHEREAS:

1. The City and County of San Francisco (City) has requested a \$2,014,733 loan from the SRF to refinance construction of the stormwater quality control component of its Mariposa Facility Project (Project).
2. The project for which a SRF loan is requested will enable the City to comply with waste discharge requirements issued by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region.
3. The project will result in a significant reduction in nonpoint source pollution loading to the San Francisco Bay, an impaired waterbody.
4. The City approved a Negative Declaration on May 27, 1988 and no adverse impacts to water quality were noted.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Intended Use Plan is amended to include the City's Project.
2. That the Nonpoint Source Management Plan is amended to include the City's project.
3. That the SRF Priority List is amended to include the City's Project as a fundable project.
4. That an SRF loan of \$2,014,733 is approved for the City, with a repayment period of 20 years, and that the first repayment is to be due one (1) year after first disbursement of SRF funds.
