# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 91-7

# APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO--MARIPOSA PROJECT

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The City and County of San Francisco (City) has requested a \$2,014,733 loan from the SRF to refinance construction of the stormwater quality control component of its Mariposa Facility Project (Project).
- 2. The project for which a SRF loan is requested will enable the City to comply with waste discharge requirements issued by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region.
- 3. The project will result in a significant reduction in nonpoint source pollution loading to the San Francisco Bay, an impaired waterbody.
- 4. The City approved a Negative Declaration on May 27, 1988 and no adverse impacts to water quality were noted.

### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Intended Use Plan is amended to include the City's Project.
- 2. That the Nonpoint Source Management Plan is amended to include the City's project.
- 3. That the SRF Priority List is amended to include the City's Project as a fundable project.
- 4. That an SRF loan of \$2,014,733 is approved for the City, with a repayment period of 20 years, and that the first repayment is to be due one (1) year after first disbursement of SRF funds.
