APPROVAL OF THE NOMINATION OF MORRO BAY FOR THE NATIONAL ESTUARY PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- Section 320 of the Clean Water Act authorized the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Administrator to convene Management Conferences to maintain the water quality in estuaries of national significance.
- Morro Bay is an estuary of national significance, with a potential for significant degradation to its water quality.
- 3. The required State matching funds will be provided by local funding sources.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- That the State Board authorizes the Chairman of the State Water Resources Control Board to sign the nomination of Morro Bay for the National Estuary Program.
- 2. That the Chairman of the State Board transmit the Nomination to the Secretary of Environmental Affairs for consideration.
- 3. That the State Board recommend that the nomination be forwarded to the Governor of California for approval.
