# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 91-13

## APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR THE WALKER RIVER IRRIGATION DISTRICT

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. The Walker River Irrigation District (District) has requested a \$350,000 loan from the SRF to implement a Sediment Removal Plan for the East Walker River (Plan).
- 2. Implementation of the Plan will enable the District to comply with a Cleanup and Abatement Order issued by the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region and a Mono County Justice Court order.
- Implementation of the Plan will result in a significant reduction of nonpoint source pollution in the East Walker River, a trophy brown trout stream.
- 4. The Plan was required pursuant to an enforcement action and is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), (Public Resources Code Section 21000, et seq.) in accordance with Section 15321, Chapter 3, Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.

### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Intended Use Plan is amended to include the District's Plan.
- 2. That the Nonpoint Source Management Plan is amended to include the District's Plan.
- 3. That the SRF Priority List is amended to include the District's Plan as a fundable project.
- 4. That a SRF Loan of \$350,000 is approved for the City, contingent upon approval by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency of an amendment to the SRF Operating Agreement to include acceptance of a CEQA categorical exemption for SRF Loans.
- 5. That the repayment period shall be 10 years, and that the first payment is to be due one (1) year after first disbursement of SRF funds.
