RESOLUTION NO. 91-19

REQUEST BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY  
TO INCREASE THE CITY OF WATSONVILLE'S  
CLEAN WATER GRANT FUNDS -- CLEAN WATER GRANT NO. C-06-1128-120

WHEREAS:

1. The Environmental Protection Agency has requested that the State Water Resources Control Board consider increasing C-06-1124-120 for the City of Watsonville (City);
2. The City has anticipated a cost overrun due mainly to a contractor's claim; and
3. The final eligible cost have not been determined.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Reserves \$4,272,877 in Environmental Protection Agency grant funds until such time as the final eligible cost are known on C-06-1128-120; and
2. When the final eligible cost are known, the Board will consider increasing the City's grant.
