## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 91-25

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO (CITY) ISLAIS CREEK TRANSPORT/STORAGE--CONTRACT "A"

## WHEREAS:

- The State Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities", and amended it on September 20, 1990;
- The State Board, on September 20, 1990, adopted the FFY 1991 SRF Loan Program Priority List which includes the Islais Creek Transport/Storage project as unscheduled;
- 3. The City has requested that the State Board amend the FFY 1991 SRF Loan Program Priority List to include the City's project in the fundable year;
- 4. The State Board, on September 20, 1990, approved a 20 percent set aside of the FFY 1991 Capitalization Grant and the State's match for construction of new collection systems and combined sewer overflow correction projects;
- 5. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and the revenue program for the City and County of San Francisco Islais Creek Transport/Storage facility; and
- 6. The information contained in the Negative Declaration and Initial Study prepared for the project (State Clearinghouse No. 88092008) has been reviewed and considered and it has been determined that:
  - (a) Changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into, the project which avoid or substantially lessen the potential significant environmental impacts identified in the Negative Declaration and Initial Study with respect to the following aspects of the project: (i) dewatering impacts will be mitigated by using a holding tank to allow settling of dewatering water and by installing monitoring wells to check subsidence; (ii) hazardous waste impacts associated with soil and ground water will be mitigated by performing site investigations, preparing mitigation plans, undertaking cleanup, and properly disposing of contaminated materials as necessary; (iii) cultural resources impacts will be mitigated, when evidence of cultural resources are found, by notifying the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board, stopping construction and bringing in an archaeologist to assist in preparing an archaeological findings report used to make appropriate recommendations.
  - (b) With respect to the other potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the Negative Declaration and Initial Study, appropriate changes or alterations are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of other public agencies and such other changes or alterations have been adopted or can and should be adopted by such other agencies.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

- 1. Amend the SRF Loan Program Priority List to include the City's project in the fundable year.
- Approve a SRF loan of \$6 million for Contract A of the Islais Creek Transport/Storage facilities, Project No. C-06-4025-410, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first repayment to be due one (1) year after the first loan disbursement.
