# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 91-58

## APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN FOR THE CITY OF DAVIS

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. The City of Davis has requested a \$4.9 million loan from the State Revolving Fund (SRF) to implement its Program to Reduce Pollutant Loading from Point and Nonpoint Discharges (Program).
- The Program consists of a Wetland Project and a Pollution Load Reduction Program at a combined cost of \$6.96 million. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will provide partial funding for the Wetland Project with a grant of \$1.49 million. The City of Davis will provide the remaining \$570,000.

### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- That the Intended Use Plan is amended to include the City of Davis' Project.
- 2. That the Nonpoint Source Management Plan is amended to include the City of Davis' Project.
- 3. That the SRF Priority List is amended to include the City of Davis' Project as a fundable project.
- 4. That a SRF loan of \$4.9 million is approved for the City of Davis, with a repayment period of 20 years, and that the first repayment is to be due one (1) year after completion of the Project.
