STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 91-59

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR THE CITY OF RICHMOND WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS:

- The State Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities", and amended it on September 20, 1990;
- The State Board, on September 20, 1990, adopted the Federal Fiscal Year 1991 SRF Loan Program Priority List which includes the Richmond Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements project as a Class C project;
- The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and the draft revenue program for the Richmond Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements project; and
- 4. The information contained in the Negative Declaration and Initial Study prepared for the project (State Clearinghouse No. 90030960), adopted by the Richmond City Planning Commission on June 6, 1991, has been reviewed and considered, and it has been determined that the proposed project would not result in significant adverse environmental impacts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

Approves an SRF loan of \$8.8 million for the City of Richmond Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements, Project No. C-06-4039-110, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first repayment to be due one (1) year after completion of construction.
