# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 91-72

# APPROVAL OF A REQUEST FOR A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN FOR THE CITY OF STOCKTON

#### WHEREAS:

- The City of Stockton (City) has requested a \$1.9 million loan from the State Revolving Fund (SRF) to implement its <u>Program to Reduce Pollutant</u> <u>Loading from Urban Runoff</u> (Program);
- 2. Implementation of the Program will advance the City toward compliance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the control of pollutants in stormwater discharges; and
- 3. The City's Program is statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15262 of the State CEQA guidelines.

### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- That the Intended Use Plan for the SRF is amended to include the City's Program to Reduce Pollutant Loading from Urban Runoff.
- 2. That the Nonpoint Source Management Plan is amended to include the City's Program to Reduce Pollutant Loading from Urban Runoff.
- 3. That an SRF loan of \$1.9 million is approved for the City of Stockton, with a repayment period of ten years, and that the first payment is to be due one (1) year after completion of the City's three-(3) year Program.
- That the SRF Priority List is amended to include the City's Program as a fundable project.
