RESOLUTION NO. 91-99

AUTHORIZATION TO OFFER A WATER RECLAMATION LOAN
TO LOS ANGELES COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICTS
FOR THE PUENTE HILLS RECLAIMED WATER
DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM PROJECT

WHEREAS:


1. The Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 and the Clean Water and Water Reclamation Bond Law of 1988 established the Water Reclamation Loan Program to provide financial assistance for the design and construction of cost-effective water reclamation projects;
2. The Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 established the revolving Water Reclamation Account (Account) and provided \$25 million for loans. The repayments from these loans will be returned to the revolving Account;
3. The Bond Law of 1988 provided \$30 million for loans for water reclamation projects. The repayments of these loans will be returned to the State General Fund;
4. A loan application was submitted by Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts and the Division of Clean Water Programs has reviewed the application, planning documents and other supporting information for the Puente Hills Reclaimed Water Distribution System Project. The Division has determined that the submitted documents comply with the Water Reclamation Loan Program Guidelines; and
5. The information contained in the Puente Hills Negative Declaration (State Clearinghouse No. 9011023) has been reviewed and considered, and:
 - a. Mitigation measures have been incorporated into the project which avoid or substantially lessen the potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the Final Negative Declaration with respect to short term erosion, dust control, noise levels and short term traffic alteration. These impacts will be mitigated by including erosion control and restoration measures in project design, dust control measures and restricting construction activities to comply with Los Angeles County and City of Industry noise ordinances; traffic control and highway safety equipment will be used to reduce hazards.
 - b. With respect to the other potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the Negative Declaration, appropriate changes or alterations are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of other public agencies and such other changes or alterations have been adopted or can and should be adopted by such other agencies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

Approves the proposed project, and authorizes a loan to Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts for the estimated amount of \$5.0 million, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years beginning on the date of the contract.
