

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 92-02

APPROVAL TO AWARD A SMALL COMMUNITY GRANT TO
MENDOCINO CITY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

WHEREAS:

1. Mendocino City Community Services District (CSD) has requested grant funds for construction of wastewater treatment works to serve the District, as provided by the Clean Water and Water Reclamation Bond Law of 1988;
2. Mendocino City CSD has been included on the State Board's Small Community Grant Program Priority List;
3. Mendocino City CSD has a population of 585, and the median household income is estimated at \$17,900;
4. The total project cost per household for Mendocino City CSD will be about \$600 which is less than \$14,000;
5. The Division of Clean Water Programs has issued concept approval and has approved the plans and specifications for the proposed project;
6. This project qualifies for a Categorical Exemption (Class 1) of the California Environmental Quality Act and a Notice of Exemption (No. 91083052) has been filed with the State Office of Planning and Research; and
7. In accordance with the State Board's Implementation Policy for the Small Community Grant Program, the estimated grant amount for Mendocino City CSD is \$147,000.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Has determined that Mendocino City CSD is eligible for a grant under the Clean Water and Water Reclamation Bond Law of 1988; and
2. Approves the award of a Small Community Grant to Mendocino City CSD of \$147,000 for construction of the dewatering system at the Mendocino City CSD sewage treatment plant.
