STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 92-07

APPROVAL OF A LIST OF CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT PROJECTS FOR THE 1991-1992 FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board approved procedures for administration of the Cleanup and Abatement Account (Account) as included in Chapter 4.4 of the State Board's Administrative Procedures manual;
- 2. The Division of Clean Water Programs (Division) has surveyed the Regional Boards to obtain a list of cleanup and abatement projects and their expected costs, including staff costs, for fiscal year 1991-92.
- 3. The only Regional Board that responded to the Division's survey was the Lahontan Region, which proposed five projects at an estimated cost of \$1,270,000, and subsequent to the survey, proposed a \$95,000 engineering study at the Leviathan Mine;
- 4. Two of the projects relate to the cleanup of underground storage tank sites, which are more appropriately funded by the Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund;
- 5. There are sufficient funds in the Account, and the State Board has stated it will attempt to distribute the funds in approximate proportion to the previous fiscal year cash receipts from each Regional Board, and;
- 6. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region, contributed \$70,000, to the Account or 2.61 percent of all the money received in fiscal year 1990-91 from the Regional Boards.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

Allocates \$310,000 from the fiscal year 1991-92 Cleanup and Abatement Account for the following projects:

Leviathan Mine	Acid mine drainage pilot study	\$ 95,000
