STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 92-16

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR THE MISSION SPRINGS WATER DISTRICT ALAN L. HORTON WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities" and amended it on September 20, 1990;
- The State Board on September 26, 1991, adopted the Federal Fiscal Year 1992 SRF Loan Program Priority List which includes the Mission Springs Water District Expansion Project for the Alan L. Horton Wastewater Treatment Plant;
- The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and the draft revenue program for the subject project; and
- 4. The State Board has reviewed and considered the information contained in the Project Report for the Alan L. Horton Wastewater Treatment Plant, dated April 1991, and the Initial Study and Final Negative Declaration (SCH No. 91122040) adopted by the Mission Springs Water District on January 10, 1992, and has determined that the proposed project would not have a significant effect on the environment.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

Approves an SRF loan not to exceed 1.2 million for the Mission Springs Water District expansion project for the Alan L. Horton Wastewater Treatment Plant (SRF Project No. C-06-4250-110), with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first repayment to be due one (1) year after the completion of construction.
