RESOLUTION NO. 92-26

DIRECTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO APPROVE A NO-COST ONE-YEAR TIME EXTENSION AMENDMENT TO STANDARD AGREEMENT NO. 8-139-120-0 WITH CLEMENT ASSOCIATES TO CONTINUE REVIEW OF THE BASELINE PUBLIC HEALTH EVALUATIONS (BPHEs) AND FEASIBILITY STUDY (FS) RISK ASSESSMENTS IN SUPPORT OF THE SOUTH BAY MULTI-SITE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT (MSCA) SUPERFUND SITES

WHEREAS:


1. The Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Regional Board) is responsible for regulating toxic spills and underground storage tank leak cleanups to protect the South Bay drinking water supplies from contamination. The Regional Board has lead responsibility for cleanup of 22 Superfund sites.
2. The MSCA grant special conditions and federal Superfund law and regulations require review of BPHEs and FS risk assessments prior to adoption of final cleanup plans for Superfund sites.
3. Clement Associates has previously been awarded a contract to review the Responsible Parties' BPHEs and FS Risk Assessments. Due to technical difficulties on the part of the Responsible Parties and addition of new work, the Responsible Parties' progress has been slowed and they have not been able to submit the required BPHE and FS risk assessments for review by Clement Associates.
4. Additional time is needed in the Clement contract to complete all the work in progress and to meet MSCA requirements. Clement Associates has agreed to a no-cost time extension of the existing contract.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to execute a no-cost one-year time extension to Standard Agreement No. 8139-120-0 with Clement Associates to continue review of BPHEs and FS risk assessments.
