

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 92-39

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT AND AMEND A TWO-YEAR,
TEN MILLION DOLLAR COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT
OF DEFENSE (DoD) FOR FISCAL YEARS 1992-93 AND 1993-94

WHEREAS:

1. The DoD has available approximately \$10 million for a two-year agreement for State and Regional Water Board oversight of cleanup activities at about 100 DoD facilities.
2. The Department of Toxic Substances Control, in cooperation with the State Water Board, is negotiating a similar agreement with DoD.
3. Approval of this Cooperative Agreement will ensure that there will be a coordinated state agency oversight of the DoD facility cleanup activities, including those activities at closing bases.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Board authorizes the Executive Director to accept and amend an approximately \$10 million, two-year cooperative agreement with DoD for oversight of the cleanup of federal facilities during Fiscal Years 1992-93 and 1993-94.
