RESOLUTION NO. 92-60

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN
FOR FALLBROOK PUBLIC UTILITIES DISTRICT
RECLAIMED WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities" and amended it on September 20, 1990;
2. The State Water Board, on September 26, 1991, adopted the FFY 1992 SRF Loan Program Priority List which includes the Fallbrook Public Utilities District's Reclaimed Water Distribution System Project;
3. The Fallbrook Public Utilities District has requested that the State Water Board amend the FFY 1992 SRF Loan Program Priority List to include their project in the fundable year;
4. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and the revenue program for the Reclaimed Water Distribution System Project; and
5. The Fallbrook Public Utilities District has adopted a Negative Declaration for the proposed project (State Clearinghouse No. 91081043) which has been reviewed and considered by the State Water Board, and it has been determined that the proposed project will not result in significant negative environmental impacts.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That The State Water Board:

1. Amends the FFY 1992 SRF Loan Program Priority List to reschedule the Fallbrook Public Utilities District's Reclaimed Water Distribution System Project to FFY 1992 for funding; and
2. Approves an SRF loan of \$2.7 million for the Fallbrook Public Utilities District Reclaimed Water Distribution Project, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first repayment due one (1) year after completion of construction.
