DENIAL OF STATE WATER POLLUTION CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT FUNDS FOR CLEANUP OF THE SAND CITY ABANDONED DUMP SITE

WHEREAS:

- 1. The City of Sand City Redevelopment Agency (Agency) has requested \$20,000 from the State Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account (Account) for Phase I rehabilitation of the Old Sand City Dump;
- 2. The degradation of groundwater and surface water caused by leachate from the waste material has not been established;
- 3. The California Integrated Waste Management Board's Solid Waste Disposal Site Cleanup and Maintenance account is the appropriate funding source available to the Agency for implementing necessary corrective action at the site; and
- 4. Commitment of funds from the Account to complete both phases of the proposed rehabilitation would deplete the Account to the Point that the reserve of \$1,000,000 for unanticipated cleanup situations would be jeopardized.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board denies funds from the State Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account to cleanup the Sand City abandoned dump sites.
