STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 92-71

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN FOR THE SONOMA VALLEY COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT RECLAMATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities", and amended it on September 20, 1990;
- 2. The State Water Board, on September 26, 1991, adopted the FFY 1992 SRF Loan Program Priority List which includes the Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District's Reclamation Project;
- 3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and revenue program for the Reclamation Project; and
- 4. The Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District has certified an EIR (State Clearinghouse No. 79121815) and prepared an Environmental Checklist for the proposed project which has been reviewed and considered by the State Water Board, and it has been determined that the proposed project will not result in significant adverse environmental impacts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Board approves an SRF loan of \$1.5 million for the Sonoma Valley County Sanitation District's Reclamation Project, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first repayment due one (1) year after completion of construction.
