RESOLUTION NO. 92-88

APPROVING THE WORKPLAN FOR TRIENNIAL REVIEW
OF THE CALIFORNIA OCEAN PLAN (OCEAN PLAN)

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Board adopted the Ocean Plan on July 6, 1972 and revised the Plan in 1978, 1983, 1988, and 1990.
2. The State Water Board is responsible for reviewing Ocean Plan water quality standards and for modifying and adopting standards in accordance with Section 303(c)(1) of the Federal Clean Water Act and Section 13170.2(b) of the California Water Code.
3. The State Water Board conducted a public hearing in Newport Beach on November 13, 1991 to solicit comments regarding the review and revision of water quality standards contained in the Ocean Plan, and has reviewed and considered carefully all comments and testimony received.
4. The State Water Board has set a priority for each issue and selected a list of issues that will be reviewed within the next two years.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The State Water Board adopts the Ocean Plan Triennial Review and Workplan and authorizes the Executive Director to transmit the workplan to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 9, in compliance with Section 303(c)(1) of the Clean Water Act.
2. Directs the staff to review each of the higher priority issues by November 1, 1994 and to make recommendations to the State Water Board for any necessary changes to the Ocean Plan.
3. May amend the Ocean Plan annually or as each major issue analysis is completed.
4. Authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute contracts developed in accordance with the approved workplan and to make changes in the workplan as appropriate, only after the State Water Board and EPA are informed of such required workplan changes.

5. Affirms that the Ocean Plan, as it currently exists, remains effective until such time as it is changed by formal action of the State Water Board.
